- ◆ providing emotional, practical and social support for individuals, their caregivers, families and friends throughout the last stage of illness, at the time of death and during bereavement.
- ◆ funded through general donations, our Second Story Treasures Thrift Store in Walnut Grove, fundraising events, memorial and in-honor gifts, planned giving, community grants, BC Gaming, United Way and a service contract with Fraser Health.

Hospice isn't just a building or residence, it's a philosophy of care and support that...

- ◆ provides sensitivity and support for individuals experiencing a terminal illness.
- ◆ emphasizes comfort, dignity and quality of life.
- ◆ affirms life and neither hastens nor postpones death.
- ◆ is available to patients and their families at home, in hospital, in hospice residence or community care facility.

In addition to palliative support through the hospice residence and in the community, the **Langley Hospice Society** provides a number of important programs and services, free of charge to the community we serve. These include:

Palliative Care and Support

Staff and volunteers provide support to clients in their homes, in the hospice residence, hospital or care facility; in-home respite support for caregivers and vigil support available upon request

Individual and Group Grief Support

Anticipatory, early and ongoing grief support for children, teens, adults and families

Adult Bereavement Programs

Supportive Steps Walking Group, and Cooking for One

Children and Youth Bereavement Programs

Summer camp and day camps for grieving children and teens

Education and Advocacy

In-house and community outreach and educational presentations to schools, community groups and the general public
