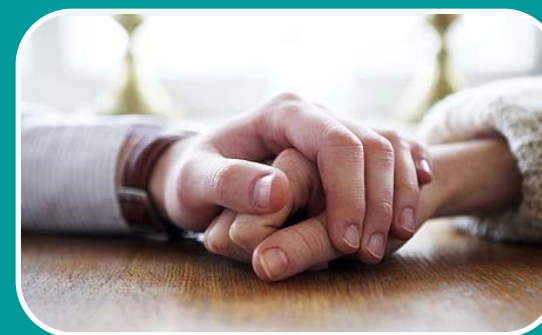

- ◆ affirms life and neither hastens nor postpones death.
- ◆ is available to patients and their families at home, in hospital, in hospice residence or community care facility.
